



The Nippon Foundation's support to conflict-affected people in Myanmar

The Nippon Foundation (TNF) has been working with the Government of Myanmar, ethnic armed organizations in Myanmar, and the Government of Japan since 2012 to achieve peace in Myanmar. We have been doing this in promoting confidence building and dialog between the Government of Myanmar and ethnic armed organizations, and by distributing approximately USD 21 million of food and other humanitarian assistance to the country's roughly 950,000 conflict-affected people.
