Afternoon	- Visit the Hall of Opium - While the Doi Tung Development Project helped solve the problems of drug supply, HRH the Princess Mother recognized that the fight against drugs also needs to address through drug demand. The Hall of Opium was created to help reduce the demand through interactive learning approach on opium in the Golden Triangle, an infamous area for its poppy fields, drug smugglers, and opium warlords, and elsewhere in the world - Drive along Mekong river, visit Chiang Sean, the oldest settlements in the Kingdom of Thailand as early as the 7th century - Dinner at the Golden Triangle (restaurant along Mekong river)	Time to be discussed
